About:

This grazing school will be held at the First Christian Church (409 College St.) in Greenfield, MO. Classes begin about 9:00 a.m. and will end at approx. 4:30 p.m. on all days. This grazing school is applicable to all types of livestock, though beef will be emphasized. Completion of this school may help qualify you for cost-share programs (check with your local MO SWCD office for more information).

- Fencing and Water Systems
- Matching Livestock and Forage Resources
- Meeting Nutritional Needs of Livestock from Pasture

- Economics of Management-intensive Grazing Plus
- Outdoor Field Exercises and Tour of Producers’ Farms

Registration Information:

Registration is due by September 5th. Register early to insure a place in the school. Cost is \$200 per person and \$100 for each additional person from the same farm operation (will receive only one set of printed materials). This fee includes the Missouri Grazing Handbook, Forages and Weeds of Pastures, Watering Systems for Serious Graziers, Electric Fencing for Serious Graziers and a grazing stick, as well as lunches and refreshments during breaks.
