

2025 Traffic Safety Art Contest

About the Contest

The TxDOT Traffic Safety Art Contest challenges K-8 students to create artwork that promotes key traffic safety messages. This is an opportunity for students to showcase their creativity while learning about important roadway safety topics.

Who Can Participate?

- Open to K-8 students in the following counties: Coke, Concho, Crockett, Edwards, Glasscock, Irion, Kimble, Menard, Reagan, Real, Runnels, Schleicher, Sterling, Sutton, and Tom Green.
- Students will compete in two categories: K-4 and 5-8.

Important Dates

- Contest Opens: March 1, 2025 (Saturday)
- Submission Deadline: April 15, 2025 (Tuesday)
- Winners Announced: April 28, 2025 (Monday)

How to Enter

- Students create an original artwork based on one of TxDOT's traffic safety themes (see below).
- Artwork can be created using any medium (crayons, markers, paint, digital, etc.).
- Each submission must:
 - Be 6" by 9"
 - Include student's name, grade, school, and county
 - Title of artwork
 - A short description (1-2 sentences) explaining the message
- All artworks should be submitted to the nearest drop off location or mailed in by April 15th, 2025

Traffic Safety Themes

Students should create artwork that represents one of TxDOT's safety messages, such as:

- Buckle Up - Always Wear Your Seat Belt
- Eyes on the Road - No Texting & Driving
- Stay Alert in School Zones

- Winning designs will also be turned into postcards for outreach.

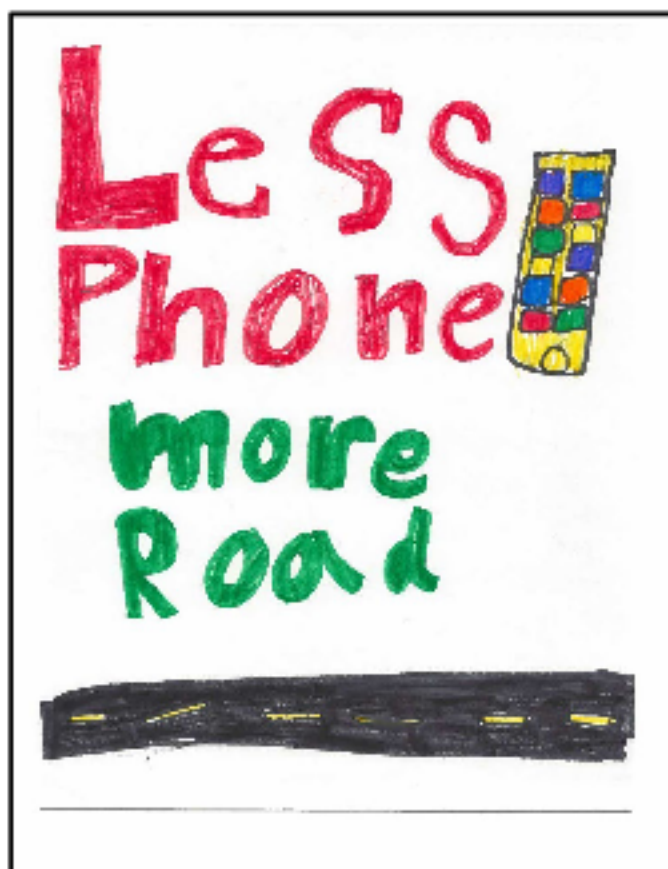
